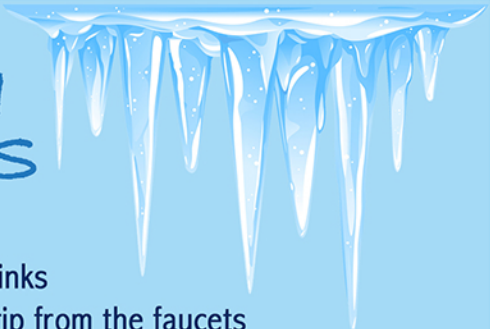
FROZEN PIPE TIPS

Prevention:

- *open cabinet doors to sinks
- *maintain a cold-water drip from the faucets
- *apply heat tape to pipes
- *secure skirting of home

To thaw a frozen pipe:

- *keep faucet open; the running water will help melt the ice
- *apply heat to the pipe by using a hair dryer or portable space heater or wrap with an electric heating pad
